MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES

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CLEANING

To keep your watch in pristine condition, we recommend cleaning it on a regular basis using a non-abrasive cloth.

WATER RESISTANCE

Water resistance prevents dust and humidity from entering the watch as well as any risk of damage when the watch is submerged in water.

Most Ralph Lauren watches are water resistant 3 bar, 5 bar, or more. This means that they have been tested at pressures corresponding approximately to depths of 30 or 50 meters respectively. Certain Ralph Lauren watches are water resistant up to 20 bar. This means they have been tested at pressures corresponding approximately to depths of 200 meters.

- Watches that are water resistant to 3 bar are resistant to surface water. Consequently, they will tolerate a humid environment and being submerged in a small amount of water (for example, during hand washing, rain).
- Watches that are water resistant to 5 or 10 bar share the same characteristics as watches that are water resistant to 3 bar. In addition, they can be worn when swimming as well as when diving from the edge of a pool (but not from a diving board).

Ralph Lauren watches that feature wood bezels, such as the RL Automotive Skeleton are made from natural elements. It is not recommended to swim or dive with these models.

Ralph Lauren watches should never be used for scuba diving or for sports in which there is a high risk of impact (such as wind surfing or water skiing).

When the watch is submerged, do not pull out the crown or push the buttons in order to carry out any type of operation as water could enter the case.

Finally, please note that leather straps are not suitable for water based activities.

Ralph Lauren watches are precision instruments. To keep yours in the best possible condition and to ensure that it works optimally, we recommend you have your watch checked every 2 to 3 years and fully serviced every 4 to 5 years.
